Is Pathology Update 2020 going ahead?

Yes, as a virtual conference. Pathology Update 2020 is going ahead as scheduled on Friday 20 – Sunday 22nd March 2020.

What is a virtual conference?

All sessions will be live streamed and made available for all registered and paid delegates to view from home/work.

How will delegates access the live stream?

A link to your personal live-stream and instructions will be sent to registered delegates prior to the commencement of Pathology Update.

Will the live-streaming be recorded for Pathology Update 2020?

No, sessions will not be recorded.

Why has The RCPA not cancelled Pathology Update 2020?

The RCPA recognises the educational value of Pathology Update and wish to continue to provide this activity for the CPDP and educational benefits in a safe format.

RCPA continues to take their advice from official health channels, including NSW Health (NSW Health), the Australian Government (Australian Government COVID-19 alert) and the Australian Health Protection Principal Committee (AHPPC).

I am a trainee and was using my poster presentation to partially fulfil my Portfolio Training Requirements, what do I do?

The Chief Examiners have agreed to accept and verify Posters as evidence towards your PPD, despite you not getting the opportunity to display it at Pathology Update. A post-Pathology Update Teleconference session with Fellows will be offered, enabling you to present your Poster and be questioned. Information regarding this teleconference will be communicated to trainees in this

situation **AFTER** the completion of Pathology Update.

I am presenting an oral/poster in the Trainee Prize categories, what do I do?

The BEA, DS Nelson and RCPAQAP Oral presentations on Friday 20 March 2020 will be live streamed and presenters will be emailed instructions.
